### Emergency Ride Home Program (ERH)

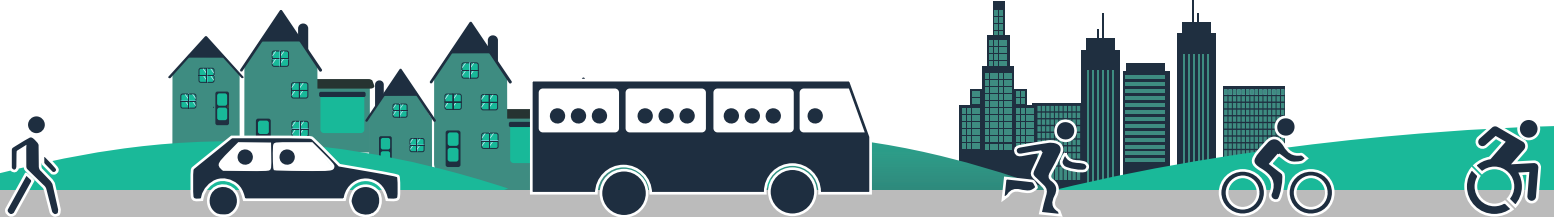
